Since time immemorial, scholars celebrate Kumbh by diving into the holy Ganga And preaching to the pilgrims on dharma (Good Governance). The spiritual, mesmerizing, and epiphanic value of Kumbh Mela in India leaves an indelible imprint on the minds of the devout pilgrims.

Kumbh Conclave 2019 at Prayagraj and Goa Kumbh Conclave 2019 at Prayagraj and Goa was to practice and re-establish the same spiritual values of this biggest festival on earth with the discussion on economics, politics, society, science, and culture as part of good governance (Dharma) with the scholars from all across the world.

Kumbh Conclave is a seasoned dialogue platform to discuss contemporary issues during the time of Kumbh.

Other than the spiritual values of the occasion, it is the world's best place to experience a perfect example of public administration, town planning, social governance, and civic management where crores of people come, stay in the city of makeshift tents at the sands with all the facilities of public utility, police, and security, railway and bus arrangements, sanctity and cleanliness, roads of the chequered plate, pontoon bridges, water supply, drainage, markets & stalls, and powerhouses for the regular supply of electricity and other infrastructure facilities available in any established city.

For almost 3 months (differ with Haridwar /Nashik/Ujjain) a new city is formed at the confluence of holy rivers which is recognized as an intangible heritage in the UNESCO now.

We organized the First Kumbh Conclave of this country from 27-29th July 2019 in the city Prayagraj and then in Goa during November 2018, before the actual Kumbh at Triveni Sangam.

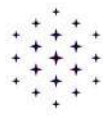
